I also understand that my travel expenses will not be covered, unless travelling outside of the London area. Some meals will be provided.

I agree to give over any rights I may have in the finished film to Mian-Cat Productions, to allow them to distribute the film in any and every way they can.

I acknowledge that Sharifah will rely on the waivers, releases and permissions granted herein potentially, at substantial cost to Mian-Cat Productions and hereby agree not to assert any claim of any nature whatsoever against anyone relating to the exercise of the permissions granted hereunder.
